Abstract Submission Instructions

Abstracts should be submitted in English as Word documents, maximum of one page in length (including references, disclaimers and any attached table or figure), all borders set to 2cm, Times New Roman font size 12. Your abstract will be rejected if these instructions are not adhered to.

Please specify at the start of your document the category into which your work falls:

- Case Report
- Quality Improvement
- Training and Education
- Research
- Equipment

Title

Give the working title of your document

Authors

All authors' initials, last names and place where work was carried out should be listed, with an asterisk (*) to indicate the corresponding author, and an email address for the corresponding author provided next to their name.

Body of Text

The text should contain the following headings; introduction, methods, results and conclusions. Case reports should be structured introduction, case history, discussion. Headings in bold and underlined. Single spacing between paragraphs.

References

Up to three references may be provided, referred to by superscript numbers in the body of the text, and listed in the style used by the British Journal of Anaesthesia. If more than three authors, give the first three names followed by “et al.”

Disclaimer

Please include a statement to declare that all authors have been involved in the preparation of your manuscript, declare any source of funding, sponsorship or conflict of interest, and acknowledge that the relevant approval was obtained for your work, i.e. patient consent for a case report, local registration of an audit/QI project, ethics committee approval for research. Abstracts which do not contain such a disclaimer will be rejected.

Figures/Tables

You may include one table or figure at the end of your manuscript, it should be referenced at the appropriate point in your text. (E.g. “as is shown in Table 1.”)

Submission and Acceptance

Submit your entries to GAMCpostercompetition@gmail.com by midday on Wednesday the 15th of May. You will be notified of whether your entry has been accepted by Monday the 20th of May. If your abstract is accepted, you should prepare an A1 poster to be displayed on the first day of the Conference, Thursday 20th June. Presenting authors must be registered to attend the course on that day.
